





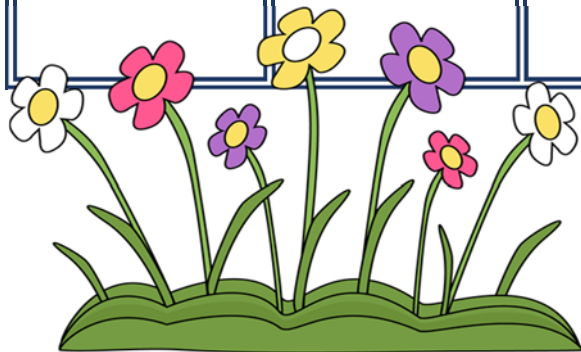


# Language Calendar 2017



Decorate for Spring; talk about each decoration and where it goes	Visit your local library and check-out a book about colors	Use plastic cups and paper to build a tower; talk about how tall you make it	Use shapes to make flowers; talk about the shapes you use 	Before planting flowers, compare the flower seeds and talk about how they are the same/different
Dye milk with food coloring and paint bread; talk about the colors you make	Stack plastic eggs and make a pattern; talk about the pattern you make	Dye eggs! Go to <a href="http://www.moogcenter.org">www.moogcenter.org</a> for language ideas 	Find toys or items in your house for each number, 1-10 (3 towels, 4 cars, 5 spoons)	While going through a car wash, talk about everything that's happening
Drip glue on paper to make rain; talk about each step	Put a Peep in water and talk about what happens 	Find items in magazines/catalogs that start with the same letter as your name	Play restaurant; practice taking orders and giving your order	Go outside and look at your house; label 3 parts of the house ( <i>garage, chimney, roof</i> ) 
Go for a walk in the rain and count the puddles as you splash 	Hide an object in a bag/box; have someone ask questions to guess the object	Use a paper plate to make a snake; use scissors to cut the plate as you turn it	While painting a picture, mix colors and talk about the new colors you make 	Make Kool-Aid; talk about each step and the flavor you pick
Talk about all the parts of a flower	Name and talk about 3 baby animals ( <i>calf, chick, duckling</i> )	Using blocks measure the length of various objects; count to see how many blocks long an object is	Use chalk to draw a long curvy line on your sidewalk/driveway; try to walk on the line, not stepping off it	Play hide-n-seek with Easter eggs or other objects; talk about where they were hiding using prepositions like <i>in, on, under, next to, behind</i>



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
