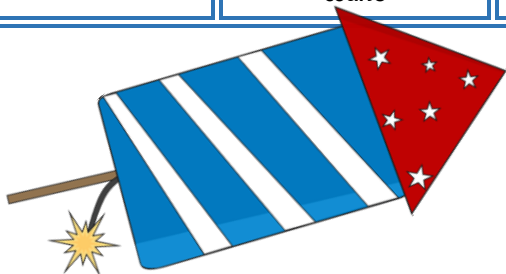

<p>Put on a play of "The Three Little Pigs"; talk about who will play each character</p>	<p>Play in the sprinkler; talk about all the actions you can do in the water (<i>jump, spin, hop, etc.</i>)</p> 	<p>Label and talk about the areas outside your house (<i>patio, deck, porch, lawn, driveway, etc.</i>)</p>	<p>Read <i>Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What Do You See?</i> Go to <a href="http://www.moogcenter.org">www.moogcenter.org</a> for language ideas</p>	<p>Play a game of memory; talk about pictures you find using the words <i>same</i> and <i>different</i></p>
<p>Label the people you see while in the car (<i>man/daddy, woman/mommy, boy, girl</i>)</p>	<p>Talk about the parts of an analog clock</p> 	<p>Talk about opposites (<i>hot/cold, big/little, dirty/clean</i>)</p>	<p>Make a birthday card for someone; talk about what you will write and draw</p>	<p>Look at the sky at night; talk about the moon and how it changes</p> 
<p>Make ice cream shakes; talk about each step</p> 	<p>Tie flowers together to make a flower necklace; talk about each step</p>	<p>Play pretend library; have a librarian and pretend to check-out books</p>	<p>Make a self-portrait; talk about the parts of your face</p> 	<p>Gather objects; talk about whether they are <i>heavy</i> or <i>light</i></p>
<p>Practice making shapes; talk about the shapes you make</p>	<p>Make an obstacle course outside; talk about where you will put everything and what you need to do to complete the course</p>	<p>Practice telling others your birthday (month/day/year)</p>	<p>Take orders for lunch; practice asking what people want to eat</p>	<p>Play catch outside; talk about catching and throwing the ball</p>
