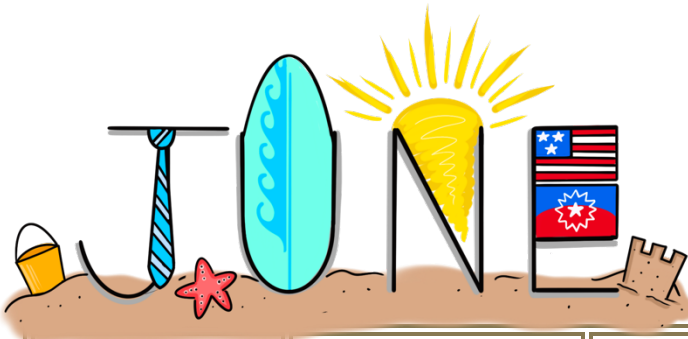


Language Calendar
